





Total FBI Index Crimes per 100,000 Population for 197 Cities with Population over 100,000 January-June 1998





Reports of Shooting Victims Calendar 1993-1998





Crime in Housing Developments Seven Major Felonies * Calendar 1995-1998



Crime in Transit System Major Felonies * Calendar 1997-1998




Grand Larceny Auto Calendar 1993-1998



Fatal Shootings by Police Officers (Ratio per 1,000 Officers)




Total Citywide Arrest Data vs. Shots Fired by Officers Calendar 1995-1998


Total Narcotics Arrests Calendar 1989-1998






Average Response Time to Crimes in Progress (in minutes) July-October 1995-1998




Citywide Average Response Times (in minutes) July-October 1997-1998




Average Response Time by Fire Units Only to All Emergencies by Borough July-October 1997-1998



Structural Fire Response Time by Borough July-October 1997-1998




Response Time to Segment 1-3 Life-Threatening Medical Emergencies (Combined EMS/Fire)* by Borough (in minutes)










Malicious False Alarms and Fire Alarm Boxes Calendar 1994-1998





Average Daily Inmate Population





Violence Incidents (Stabbings and Slashings) July-October 1994-1998





Overall On-Time Court Delivery Rate Calendar Year







Restitution Collected for Crime Victims Calendar Year 1993-1998






Use of Force Allegations July - October 1996 - 1998




Abuse of Authority Allegations July - October 1994 - 1998




Working Families as a Percent of All Families Calendar 1976-1998 *





Projects Completed On Time





Average Duration of New Construction Projects in Months




Traffic Fatalities Calendar 1989-1998





Average Waiting Time for Parking Permits for People with Disabilities (PPPDs)




Percent of Adoptable Miles Sponsored Under the Adopt-a-Highway Program





Average Backlog of Sewer Repairs July-October 1995-1998





Average Construction Duration of Projects (Days)








Scorecard Street Cleanliness Ratings July-December 1975-1998




Number of Sanitation Sections Rated Dirty July-December 1988-1998




Curbside and Containerized Residential Recycling Diversion Rate












In 1998 NYC Private Sector Employment Growth Exceeded the Nation and New York State


Total Fair Market Value Fully and Partially Taxable Properties (in Billions)


Total Fair Market Value for One Family Homes (in Billions) Fiscal 1993-2000





Total Hospital Average Length of Stay (15.5 days to 11.8 days)






Number of Primary Care Visits July-October 1992-1998




Emergency Room Visits


Average Waiting time for Mammography Screening Appointments July-September 1995-1998




New AIDS Cases* Calendar 1994-1998




Number of Deaths from HIV/AIDS Calendar 1983-1998



New Tuberculosis Cases Citywide Calendar 1994-1998







Number of Public Assistance Recipients December 1955 - January 1999





Domestic Violence Shelter Bed Capacity







Special Education Enrollment Students Placed in a Less Restrictive Setting July-October




Initial Case Referrals for Special Education Assessment July-December







Total Number of Child Adoptions Calendar 1992-1998







Enforcement Against Tobacco Sales to Minors





Percentage of Merchants Making Illegal Tobacco Sales to Minors









Percent of New Permit Applications Using Personal Computer Filing





For Hire Vehicle Driver Summonses Issued July-December 1996-1998






