Dear Joan Cusack:

I am writing to inform you that beginning this fall, the New York City Department of Transportation (NYCDOT) will be increasing the parking rates at all NYC Municipal Parking Garages citywide, as well as increasing the Quarterly Municipal Parking Permit rates at all off-street parking fields. As you know, these facilities play a vital role in providing off-street parking for longer periods of time, as well as monthly and quarterly permit parking at a significantly lower cost than other comparable, private sector, locations. As demand for parking in the city increases, these parking rates must be adjusted to manage the demand associated with a limited supply. Rates at these locations have not been increased since 2019.

The new daily and monthly rates at all Municipal Parking Garages will be effective October 1, 2024. Information on the new rates will be posted in the facility and can be found on our website at <https://nyc.gov/municipalparking>. The new rates for Quarterly Municipal Parking Permits will take effect starting January 1, 2025, in accordance with the renewal of each facility's quarterly permit cycle.
